INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROCESSING A MECHANIC'S LIEN

If a vehicle has been abandoned on any property, a Mechanic's Lien <u>CANNOT</u> be processed. You must contact your local Police Department. When the vehicle is a trailer, please use form VR-135 (Trailers only) in place of the VR-100.

Charges must go unpaid for thirty (30) days and letters must be sent at least ten (10) days prior to the sale.

If a vehicle owner disputes the amount of the charges, he/she may institute an action of replevin in the District Court. A new title will not be issued until the case has been decided by law.

The procedures below must be followed:

- · All lien holders must be notified FIRST.
- Charges for repairs, rebuilds or storage must go unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days. A Mechanic's Lien application for storage, must be accompanied by a storage contract by the owner(s) or, if applicable, a written statement from the lienor that the lienor stored the vehicle in accordance with an agreement with an insurer.
- Obtain a non-certified copy of the vehicle and current registration record to ascertain all vehicle owner(s) and lien holder(s). You may apply in person at any full service MVA or by mailing the Request for Motor Vehicle Administration Records (form DR-057) to the MVA, Certified Copies, Room 206, 6601 Ritchie Highway, Glen Burnie, MD 21062. There is a fee per record. If the vehicle has an out-of-state license plate or you have knowledge the vehicle could be registered out-of-state, you must contact the state in question for a copy of title and registration record.
- Notice of Sale: At least ten (10) days prior to the date of the auction, notice must be given by registered or certified mail return receipt requested (only the addressee's signature or an individual acting as agent will be accepted). The person(s) or business claiming lien, must send notification to:
 - · each vehicle owner must receive a separate letter
 - all of the lien holder(s)
 - MVA Mechanic's Lien Unit
 - the individual(s) who left the vehicle for repairs
- . The Notification letter must contain the vehicle year, make, vehicle identification number (VIN) and the time, date and location of sale. The vehicle must be sold at a public auction in a place convenient to the general public, specifically between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Notice must be given by publishing it once a week for two (2) successive weeks immediately preceding the sale in one or more newspapers of general circulation in the county or city in which the work was done. If the newspaper advertisement is incorrect, you will have to re-advertise and send certified letters again before the vehicle can be auctioned.
- A copy of the newspaper notice must accompany the application for title or provide details of the notification process on the completed application.

Note: Anne Arundel County, Baltimore County and Baltimore City must have a licensed Auctioneer. All other counties need to have an acting auctioneer complete the auctioneer's receipt. (A licensed auctioneer is not required).

· After the Auction, send the following to the MVA.

- Certification of Mechanic's Lien and Auctioneer's Receipt (VR-100) completed.
- Copy of the newspaper advertisement and certification from the newspaper that the ad ran twice.
- Digital Photo or Pencil tracing of the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN).
- Original signed postal receipt and copy of letter sent or the original unclaimed and unopened letters.
- A work order authorized by vehicle owner(s), a storage agreement that is signed by vehicle owner(s), or, if applicable, a written statement from the lienor that the lienor stored the vehicle in accordance with an agreement with an insurer.
- Application for Certificate of Title (VR-005) completed in full by the successful bidder.
